


ToulX was founded in 2005 by local Internet actors and maintained since then neutral stable services with the desire to sustained innovation and research promoting state of the art approach. Despite its modest size, it is distinguished in May 2015 as the first European IX operational in SDN OpenFlow, with the TouSIX project (Toulouse SDN Internet eXchange). GETTING TO TOULOUSE

From Toulouse - Blagnac Airport

T2 Tramway line: Airport - Arènes - Palais de Justice:

Connects with the metro service at Arènes (line A) and Palais de Justice (line B) stations. Departures: every1 5 minutes. Journey time : Airport > Arènes : 21 minutes, Airport > Palais de Justice : 32 minutes.

Tisséo Shuttle Bus: Airport – Coach station:

The shuttle bus operates every day except 1st May, with departures every 20 minutes. Journey time: from 20 to 45 minutes depending on traffic.

Taxi:

Book a taxi from the airport to the city: call centre +33 (0)5 61 30 02 54

What to do in the Region/ City

The banks of the River Garonne

Cité de l'Espace Museum



One of the most beautiful views of the city features the Pont Neuf, the Hôtel-Dieu Saint-Jacques, the dome of La Grave and the River Garonne. Promenades or sunbathing; in the very heart of the city, you can enjoy the banks of the river, most notably, along the Promenade Henri-Martin and at the Place de la Daurade.



The Cité de l'espace (City of Space) is a theme park focused on space and the conquest of space. It was opened in June 1997 and is located on the eastern outskirts of Toulouse, France. As of 2012, there had been more than 4 million visitors.

Cité médiévale de Carcassonne



The Cité de Carcassonne is a medieval citadel located in the French city of Carcassonne. Founded during the Gallo-Roman period, the citadel derives its reputation from its 3 kilometres (1.9 mi) long double surrounding walls interspersed by 52 towers. The town has about 2,500 years of history and has seen the Romans, Visigoths, Saracens and Crusaders.



34TH FORUM FELLOW

Kledi Andoni - Interim Representative, Albania Neutral Internet Exchange (ANIX)

Kledi got into networking since the first internet connections appeared in Albania in the mid 1990s. Since then, he has founded multiple ISPs and helped build others where he held senior technical and management roles. He has been responsible for the design and development of several national networks involving wireless copper and fiber.



Since January 2018, he has been serving as a technical and community point of contact for the newly established neutral IX in Albania ANIX.

In a climate of high competition and mistrust between the local operators, ANIX was able to create a harmonious environment that guarantees neutrality and attracts all the local traffic. In February 2019, the member ISPs and 5 more ISPs agreed to form the ANIX association within the month of May 2019. During the Euro-IX forum, ANIX wants to spread the word that there is an Internet Exchange open for business in Albania. We would like to invite international carriers and internet companies which have traffic flowing in and out of Albania to join ANIX as the best place to be close to the Albanian market. "ANIX is the first and only neutral and notfor-profit Internet Exchange point in Albania which started operations with the first three peers connected in February 2018."
